2010 UK FINALISTS: MANAGEMENT CATEGORY

The category

This award is for an exceptional organisation with the strategic vision and management systems that enable it to continuously improve its contribution to sustainable development.

1. The environmental, economic and social aspects of sustainability must be clearly integrated into the overall mission and all the policies of the organisation. There must be a clear objective to reduce the environmental impacts of the organisation's activities, together with targets and indicators for monitoring and reporting performance. The organisation must also have mechanisms in place for addressing issues of wider corporate social responsibility, such as community involvement, employee rights and supply chain impacts.

2. Management systems must be driven by the principle of stakeholder accountability, with evidence of regular and systematic dialogue at key points in the process. There must also be the commitment to certify management systems to recognised standards (EMAS, ISO 14001). In all these regards, the organisation must show that it is leading the field and setting an example that others will be inspired to follow.
